CREATIVE THINKING AND EXPRESSION

VISUAL ARTS

- ALLOW INDIVIDUAL EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS, ABILITIES AND KNOWLEDGE

EVERY CULTURE HAS ITS OWN ART FORMS

- GENERATE AND CONCEPTUALIZE ARTISTIC IDEAS AND WORK

MUSIC

- CAN BE USED TO EXPRESS AND INITIATE AESTHETIC AND PHYSICAL RESPONSES.
- PERFORMER'S INTEREST IN KNOWLEDGE OF MUSICAL WORK, UNDERSTANDING OF THEIR OWN TECHNICAL SKILLS, AND THE CONTEXT FOR A PERFORMANCE INFLUENCES THE SELECTION OF REPERTOIR

PRODUCE AND PERFORMANCE

DANCE

- MUSIC CAN BE USED TO EXPRESS AND INITIATE AESTHETIC AND PHYSICAL RESPONSES.
- DANCE LITERACY INCLUDES DEEP KNOWLEDGE AND PERSPECTIVES ABOUT SOCIETAL, CULTURAL, HISTORICAL, AND COMMUNITY CONTEXTS.

DRAMATIC AND PERFORMANCE PLAY

THEATRE

- DRAMATIC AND PERFORMANCE PLAY IS A WAY TO ACT OUT REALITY AND FANTASY AND TO SOLVE PROBLEMS.
- CREATE ROLES, IMAGINED WORLDS, AND IMPROVISED STORIES IN A DRAMATHEATRE WORK.

MEDIA ARTS

- GENERATE AND CONCEPTUALIZE ARTISTIC IDEAS AND WORK
- SELECT, ANALYZE, AND INTERPRET ARTISTIC WORK FOR PRESENTATION
- IDENTIFYING THE QUALITIES AND CHARACTERISTICS OF MEDIA ARTWORKS IMPROVES ONE'S ARTISTIC APPRECIATION AND PRODUCTION
- SHARE IDEAS FOR MEDIA ARTWORKS THROUGH GUIDED EXPLORATION OF TOOLS, METHODS, AND IMAGINING.
- WITH GUIDANCE, COMBINE ARTS FORMS AND MEDIA CONTENT, SUCH AS DANCE AND VIDEO TO FORM MEDIA ARTWORK.
